- ^(*)**OR** [(iii) they were held in a vector-protected facility in the ^(*)[approved body] ^(*)[institute] ^(*)[centre/holding] for at least 30 days prior to shipment and were subjected to a PCR test according to the WOAHC Terrestrial Manual, with negative results, carried out at least 14 days after introduction into the ^(*)[approved body] ^(*)[institute] ^(*)[centre/holding];]

- ^(*)**OR** [(ii) they were held in a vector-protected facility in the ^(*)[approved body] ^(*)[institute] ^(*)[centre/holding] for at least 30 days prior to shipment and were subjected to a serology test according to the WOAHC Terrestrial Manual, with negative results, carried out at least 28 days after introduction into ^(*)[approved body] ^(*)[institute] ^(*)[centre/holding];]
- ^(*)**OR** [(iii) they were held in a vector-protected facility in the ^(*)[approved body] ^(*)[institute] ^(*)[centre/holding] for at least 30 days prior to shipment and were subjected to a PCR test according to the WOAHC Terrestrial Manual, with negative results, carried out at least 14 days after introduction into the ^(*)[approved body] ^(*)[institute] ^(*)[centre/holding];]

AH/T124 Territory requirements (freedom from disease)

Tests must be in accordance with the requirements prescribed for international trade by the WOAHP Manual of Diagnostic Tests and Vaccines for Terrestrial Animals.

Applicable to the point **(b)(i) for Bluetongue and (c)(i) for Epizootic Haemorrhagic Disease:**

The country, territory or zone must be free of bluetongue and EHD in accordance with the WOAHP Terrestrial Animal Health Code (WOAHP Terrestrial Code).

Applicable to the points **(b)(iv) and (v) and (c)(iv) for Bluetongue and (v) for Epizootic Haemorrhagic Disease:**

Only for a territory appearing with entry "XIII" in column 6 of a document relating to 'live ungulates' published on GOV.UK, in accordance with Regulation No 206/2010⁽¹⁾, indicating an official bluetongue and epizootic haemorrhagic disease seasonally free status. In accordance with the WOAHP Terrestrial Animal Health Code, the seasonally free period is taken to conclude immediately if current climatic data or data from surveillance programme indicate an earlier resurgence of activity of adult Culicoides.

AH/T125 Territory requirements (freedom from disease)

Points **(b)** and **(c)** tests must be in accordance with the requirements prescribed for international trade by the WOAHP Terrestrial Manual.

AH/T126 Territory requirements (freedom from disease)

AH/E418 Establishment requirements
