JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- The claimant's complaints that he was subject to direct disability discrimination contrary to s13 of the Equality Act 2010 (EqA), discrimination because of something arising in consequence of disability contrary to s15 of EqA, and failures to make reasonable adjustments contrary to s20 and s21 of EqA are not upheld and are dismissed.
