# **JUDGMENT**

### The first claimant

1.The tribunal declares the first claimant's complaint of unlawful deduction from wages (non-payment of salary from 02 December 2022 until 13 January 2023) is well-founded and respondent is ordered to pay the second claimant the sum of £2880.

#### The second claimant

Case numbers 2500401/2023, 2500427/2023 and 2500428/2023

2. The tribunal declares the second claimant's complaint of unlawful

deduction from wages (non-payment of a guarantee payment) is well-

founded and the respondent is ordered to pay the second claimant the

sum of £155.

3. The tribunal declares the second claimant's complaint of unlawful

deduction from wages (non-payment of salary from 02 December 2022

until 21 December 2022) is well-founded and respondent is ordered to

pay the second claimant the sum of £1768.00.

4. The second claimant's complaint of non-payment of holiday pay is not

well-founded and is dismissed.

5. The second claimant 's complaint of unfair dismissal is well-founded.

6. The second claimant did not cause or contribute to his dismissal.

7. The respondent has established that in respect of unfair dismissal any

award to the second claimant should be reduced by 75% on the

principle set out in Polkey -v- AE Dayton Services Ltd 1988 ICR 142,

the said reduction applicable from 27 January 2023.
