A summary of current activity at the Grenfell Tower site.

- Tower site contractors, DUK, carry out regular maintenance and checks of the props (supports installed in the tower), the hoardings around the site, lighting and security systems and scaffolding.

• We know how important and sensitive a decision on the future of Grenfell Tower will be, and a decision has not yet been made.

The government is committed to supporting bereaved families, survivors and local residents and their work to determine a future memorial.
