<b>Risk Description</b>	<p>The elbow on the connecting pipework of affected gas hobs can fail resulting in a significant gas leak, regardless of whether the hob is switched on and in use. Hazards resulting from a gas leak include burns, fire and explosion and poisoning from inhalation. The risk levels vary from low risk to serious risk, with the risk presented from fire and explosion being the worst case. The risk of fire and explosion in traditional built residences is high risk, and the risk of fire and explosion in a caravan or leisure homes is serious risk.</p> <p>The products are not in conformity with the requirements of Regulation 2016/426.</p>
<b>Corrective Measures</b>	<p>Comfee, manufactured by Midea Home Appliances UK Ltd will be initiating a modification programme for their gas hob GH430GL in scope of the safety issue. The company are proposing visits to every home containing affected hobs and make them safe. OPSS is urging all affected members of the public, including those unsure whether they are impacted or not, to check the model links and contact the manufacturer.</p> <p>While all affected consumers should check the model links, owners and consumers in caravans, leisure homes and motorhomes should do this as a matter of urgency. 	<p>Petroleum Gas (LPG), they should disconnect it from the LPG cylinder immediately.</p> <p>Owners and consumers in domestic premises should continue to be vigilant.
