Who we are

This work is being carried out by the Collections, Ownership and Governance Team which is a part of the Department for Education (DfE). For the purpose of data protection legislation, the DfE is the data controller for the personal data processed as part of this data collection.

How we will use your information

We will receive personal data from the COLLECT (collections online for learning, education, children and teachers) portal. This data will help local authorities understand the true numbers of EHE children and CME in their area. It will also help to identify local issues that may be driving home education and potentially encourage more joined up working with other authorities who may be experiencing similar challenges. The provision of the data to DfE will help government understand the numbers of EHE and CME nationally and at local authority level, informing policy development aimed at supporting local authorities and future changes to the EHE framework.

The data relating to EHE and CME will be aggregate counts at Local Authority level, so no personal data will be collected on these topics. The personal data which will be collected relates to the local authority staff member completing the data return.

We will not be making your personal data available to any external organisations or any other teams within DfE.

How long we will keep your personal data

The Department for Education will keep your personal data for up to 6 months after each data collection's closure date for the purposes of contacting staff who made the data collection return. After the 6-month period your personal data entered in the data collection return will be deleted.
