- b) The flocks of origin have undergone a disease surveillance programme in accordance with EU Regulation 2160/2003 with negative results for: **Salmonella enteritidis, S.typhimurium, S.infantis, S.virchow, and S.hadar;**
- c) the flocks of origin are subject to routine monthly veterinary inspection in accordance with EU Directive 2009/158/EC governing intra-Community trade in live poultry and do not show any signs or suspicion of contagious disease;
- d) there has been no evidence of the following diseases in the flocks of origin during the past 6 months: **highly pathogenic avian influenza, bacillary white diarrhoea (Salmonella pullorum), fowl typhoid (Salmonella gallinarum), Gumboro disease, epidemic tremor (avian encephalomyelitis), Newcastle disease, Marek's disease;**
