I am writing to outline my objections to the above planning application.  
I object on the following grounds;

1. Parsonage Road
2. Infrastructure
3. Wildlife
4. Personal Reasons.

1. Currently Parsonage Road is the main road in and out of Takeley. It is struggling to accommodate the current traffic down this road and is often a source of traffic issues. Adding extra traffic to this already struggling road would cause major issues within Takeley and the surrounding areas. Especially given the already approved planning permission for 100s of houses to be accessed off this road.

2. Takeley Currently has no Doctors surgery and the surrounding areas are struggling to take up the excess, the only local dentist has no room for any adult NHS patients and the current Internet bandwidth in Takeley cannot accommodate this amount of housing.  
Also expanding Roseacres primary school when Takeley Primary School has had to close a classroom due to insufficient amount of students at the school seems to be an unnecessary addition.

3. Adjacent to the fields is a small woodland area where many species of animal, flora and fauna live. Natural woodlands in the UK are decreasing, are there any plans to rehome any Wildlife these woods call home?

4. [REDACTED] One of the reasons we moved from Harlow to Takeley was for the cleaner air and as a direct result an improvement in my health. Having this construction happening within metres of our house would cause me health issues.
