- 4. The complaint of unfair dismissal is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 5. The complaint of failure to pay a redundancy payment is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 6. The complaint of failure to pay for accrued but untaken annual leave on termination is well founded. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of £299.32 (being three days of accrued but untaken annual leave at £76.44 per day).
