Copy Pre-Release Access to National Statistics

Pre-release access arrangements within FCDO are in line with *The Pre-release Access* to Official Statistics Order 2008 which came into force on 1 December 2008. In particular, pre-release access is only allowed for a maximum of 24 hours.
