JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant's remaining claims are struck out on the grounds as follows;
 - (1) Outside the jurisdiction of the Tribunal on the grounds of being out of time and not appropriate to exercise a just and equitable discretion; and
 - (2) In accordance with the Employment Tribunal Regulations 2013, regulation 37(1)(b), unreasonable conduct.
- 2. The respondent's application for costs succeeds. The respondent is awarded, and the claimant ordered to pay, £5,000 in costs in accordance with regulation 76(1)(a) Employment Tribunals (England and Wales) Regulations 2013.
