- 1. The claimant was a disabled person within the meaning of s6 Equality Act 2010 with the impairments of IBS and anxiety from June 2019.
- 2. The claim of breach of contract relating to the alleged breach of the grievance procedure is dismissed on withdrawal.
- 3. The claim of breach of contract relating to the alleged breach of the sickness absence policy is dismissed upon withdrawal.
- 4. The claim of breach of contract relating to an alleged breach of Agenda for Change by the failure to extend the payment of sick pay until the final review meeting shall proceed to hearing.
- 5. The claim of breach of contract relating to the alleged failure to consider the two applications for Injury Allowance shall proceed to hearing.
