## JUDGMENT (RULE 21)

1. The Secretary of State for Business and Trade is added as a second respondent to the claims.
2. Each claimant set out below is entitled to a protective award under section 189 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992 for a protected period of 90 days starting on 8 April 2022.
