## JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant was employed by the respondent from 9 September 2015 to 13 January 2023. At the date of his dismissal, he was 50 years old and was paid £390.00 per week gross (£329.00 per week net).
- 2. The claimant's claim for a statutory redundancy payment is well-founded and succeeds.
- 3. The respondent shall pay the claimant a redundancy payment of **£4,095.00** (paid gross without deduction of tax and national insurance), calculated as 7 weeks' x £390.00 x 1.5.
- 4. The claimant's claim for breach of contract (failure to pay notice pay) is well-founded and succeeds.
- 5. The respondent shall pay the claimant pay in lieu of notice of 7 weeks' x  $\pounds$ 390.00 =  $\pounds$ 2,730.00 (before deduction of income tax and National Insurance).
- 6. The claimant's claim for holiday pay accrued but not taken is well founded and succeeds.

- The respondent shall pay the claimant accrued holiday pay calculated as 2.5 days' x £78.00 per day = £195.00 (before deduction of income tax and National Insurance).
- 8. The claimant's claim for unauthorised deduction from wages is well-founded and succeeds.
- 9. The respondent shall pay the claimant one week's pay for the week 14 January 2023 to 21 January 2023 = **£390.00** (before deduction of income tax and National Insurance).
