JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's complaints of victimisation are not well founded and are dismissed.
2. The claimant's complaints of detriment pursuant to section 146 TULRC 1992 are not well founded and are dismissed.
3. The detriment complaints dating from 2017; dated 27 September 2019; dated 25 and 26 December 2020 and 1 January 2021 and dated 6 January 2021 are out of time and it was reasonably practicable for the complaints to have been brought in time.
