## JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's complaints of victimisation are not well founded and are dismissed.
- 2. The claimant's complaints of detriment pursuant to section 146 TULRC 1992 are not well founded and are dismissed.
- 3. The detriment complaints dating from 2017; dated 27 September 2019; dated 25 and 26 December 2020 and 1 January 2021 and dated 6 January 2021 are out of time and it was reasonably practicable for the complaints to have been brought in time.
