Thank you for your email of 20 June 2023 to the Ministry of Defence (MOD) requesting the following information:

"How many job adverts for DIO at Grade 6 &7 in the last 12 months have asked for a Bachelor's Degree or equivalent? If this number exceeds the cost limit then I will submit two separate requests for each grade.

Of that number how many candidates have been successful using and "equivalent" qualification?"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that some of the information in scope of your request is held.

Within the last 12 months (July 2022 to July 2023) there were 18 DIO Grade 6 adverts. Nine of which asked for a qualification and nine did not. The spreadsheet at Annex A shows the qualification required and the qualification/s held by successful candidates for each of the nine job adverts that required a qualification.

Within the last 12 months (July 2022 to July 2023) there were 96 DIO Grade 7 adverts. 31 of which asked for a qualification, 65 did not. The spreadsheet at Annex B shows the qualification required and the qualification/s held by successful candidates for each of the 31 job adverts that required a qualification.

Under Section 16 (Advice and Assistance) I should explain that the FOIA gives individuals the right to ask for recorded information held by public authorities, including government departments. The information provided within the attached Annexes is the only available recorded information held in answer to your request. It is not possible to determine from recorded information alone whether the qualifications held by the candidates were of an equivalent to the qualification required, as this would be an opinion of the recruiting line manager.

If you have any queries regarding the content of this letter, please contact this office in the first instance.

If you wish to complain about the handling of your request, or the content of this response, you can request an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.gov.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review should be made within 40 working days of the date of this response.
