**NOTIFICATION OF THE DECISION TO AGREE TO THE GRANT OF CONSENT**

**Alwyn East Field Development**

We write further to our letter of 11 October 2022, which enclosed a copy of a decision (the "Decision") under Regulation 14(3) of the Offshore Oil and Gas Exploration, Production, Unloading and Storage (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2020 (the "EIA Regulations").

As set out in the Decision, the project considered by the Secretary of State under the EIA Regulations was for the Alwyn East Field Development, being the project as detailed in Environmental Statement (OPRED reference D/4264/2021) and the application for consent (OGA reference PCON/5456).

It is understood that since the Secretary of State's decision, the application for consent for this project has changed to OGA reference PCON/6573. However, we understand that there has been no change to the project itself, which remains as outlined in Environmental Statement D/4264/2021.

Since making the Decision, the Secretary of State has not obtained or received any further information that the Secretary of State considers ought to be made public because the information is directly relevant to reaching a conclusion on whether the project is likely to have a significant effect on the environment.

The Secretary of State therefore hereby confirms that the Decision and the agreement to the grant of consent notified to you in our letter of 11 October 2022 apply to the project as detailed in the application for consent PCON/6573.

Once the OGA has reached a decision on whether to grant consent, please could you promptly, within 1 day, inform [REDACTED] by email on [REDACTED] (Copying in [OPRED@Energysecurity.gov.uk](mailto:OPRED@Energysecurity.gov.uk) and [REDACTED]), that TotalEnergies E &P UK Ltd has

been notified of the decision, and the date of that decision. OPRED will then proceed to publish a notice (under Regulation 16) on the GOV.UK website and undertake its other obligations as set out in Regulation 16, regarding publication of the relevant ES decision documentation.
