I am writing following the intervention assessment of Croydon College by the Further Education (FE) Commissioner on 15 and 16 June 2023, which took place following the college's inadequate Ofsted inspection in February 2023.

From the FE Commissioner's report, it is clear that the college has begun to address the weaknesses identified by Ofsted, although there is still work to be done. I have accepted the recommendations of the FE Commissioner and urge the college to ensure they are implemented.
