- 1. The Respondent has made an unauthorised deduction from the Claimant's wages and is ordered to pay to the Claimant the gross sum of £448.47 in respect of the amount unlawfully deducted.
- The Respondent will be entitled to deduct any tax and employee's national insurance contributions due on this amount before payment to the Claimant.
- 3. The Respondent has breached the contract of employment by dismissing the Claimant without payment for his one week notice period. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the gross sum of £769.25 for damages for the breach of contract.
- The Respondent will be entitled to deduct any tax and employee's national insurance contributions due on this amount before payment to the Claimant.
