JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claim for automatic unfair dismissal because of a protected disclosure he made on 17 October 2020 fails and is dismissed.
- 2. The claim of unauthorised deductions for payment for extra wages is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 3. The claim of unauthorised deductions for payment for accrued holiday pay of 8.3 days is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 4. The claim of unauthorised deductions for SSP payment for 07 days is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 5. The claim for breach of contract for failure to pay notice pay is not well founded and is dismissed.
