JUDGMENT ENTERED AT PUBLIC PRELIMINARY HEARING

- 1. The claimant's complaint of less favourable treatment on the grounds of his sex is dismissed upon its withdrawal.
- 2. The claimant's complaint of suffering detriment by reason of being an employee representative is dismissed upon its withdrawal.
- 3. The claimant's claim for redundancy payment is dismissed upon its withdrawal.
- 4. The part of the claimant's complaint of unlawful deduction from wages which relates to holiday pay is dismissed because the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to hear it; it was brought outside of the primary time limit and it was reasonably practicable for it to have been brought within that time limit.
- 5. The claimant's complaint of failure to provide written particulars of employment is dismissed because the claimant cannot satisfy <u>section 38(2)(b) Employment Act 2022</u>.
