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## **Authorized Amendment**

## This amendment to RA 2120 incorporates:

- A substantial re-write to make the document more comprehensible, with a more logical structure.
- New AMC in 2120(1) to clarify:
- o Applicability of the RA to S2 and Certified RPAS.
- o Training Design requirements for an IR Scheme.
- o The limited privileges from an IF Competency Check (rather than an IR).
- o An option for ADH / AM(MF) to recognise a civil IR as evidence for a military IR.
- o Methodology for recognising an IR precedence in multi-pilot Aircraft.
- o Methodology for recognising IR applicability between Aircraft types.
- o Process for appointing an IRE/IRI.
- o Criteria for, and methodology to apply, PBN endorsements.
- New GM in 2120(1) to provide guidance on:
- o Use of FSTD as the practical training environment for an IR Scheme.
- o IR recognition across different types or marks.
- o The role of Command IRE (CIRE) or Command IRI (CIRI).
- Addition of AMC in 2120(2) to clarify:
- o Compliant criteria for 'Management of Automatic Systems' during an IRT, to reflect increasing prevalence of higher levels of automation including in new categories of Aircraft.
- o An option for ADH / AM(MF) to recognise a civil IRT in lieu of a military IRT.
- Inclusion of the term 'Aircrew Examiner', the definition for which is provided in the RA.
