## JUDGMENT OF PRELIMNARY HEARING

- (1) By consent, the name of the respondent is amended to Routeware Limited.
- (2) The claimant's application to amend his claim's dated 1 June 2023 is refused, save insofar as the particulars provides further information about the harassment related to race claims set out in Box 15 of the claim form.
- (3) It was reasonably practicable to submit the claim for unfair dismissal and wrongful dismissal (i.e. breach of contract) claims in time; in any event, the claims were not submitted within a reasonable period thereafter; the Tribunal therefore has no jurisdiction to deal with those claims and they are dismissed.
- (4) The disability discrimination and harassment related to race claims were submitted out of time. The Tribunal therefore has no jurisdiction to deal with those claims and they are dismissed.
