JUDGMENT

- 1. The complaint of unfair dismissal is well-founded.
- 2. The complaint of unlawful deductions from wages contrary to s 13 Employment Rights Act 1996 and presented pursuant to s 23 Employment Rights Act 1996 is dismissed for want of jurisdiction, being out of time.
- 3. The claim for holiday pay is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 4. The claim for breach of contract (notice pay) is well-founded.
- The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sums of £692.32 (basic award), £2,869.36 (compensatory award), and £500 (loss of statutory rights) in respect of the unfair dismissal, being a total of £4,061.70
- 6. No separate award is made in respect of notice pay.
