Introduction

The claim has been sent to the registered office of the company above. No response has been presented by the return date or at all, and there is no application for an extension of time. There is sufficient information on the file for me to give Judgment in the claim, the previous Judge having recorded information in a case management order which was sent to the parties.

RULE 21 JUDGMENT

- The claimant's complaint of unlawful deductions from wages/breach of contract succeeds and the respondent shall pay to him the gross sum of £700.
- 2. The claimant was not provided with a statement of employment particulars and I uplift the award by two days' pay, namely £200, there being exceptional reasons why an uplift of two weeks' pay is unjust. Those exceptional circumstances are the duration of the employment (seven days).
- 3. The total payable by the respondent is £900.
