JUDGMENT

- The complaint of unauthorised deductions from pay contrary to part II Employment Rights Act 1996 for the period between September - October 2021, is well founded. The Respondent made an unauthorised deduction by failing to pay the full amount of wages due between 1 September to 31 October 2021. The Respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of £600 deducted from pay.
- 2. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from pay contrary to part II Employment Rights Act 1996 for the period between March 2022-August 2021, is not well founded and is dismissed.
