# JUDGMENT

1. In relation to the Claims of Mr Ovidiu-Cosmin Gheorghita:

(1) the complaint as to the under-payment of a redundancy payment is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£29.70** gross in respect of an outstanding redundancy payment;

(2) the complaint as to the under-payment of notice pay is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£102.78** gross comprising £29.70 in respect of an under-payment arising from the calculation of notice pay and £73.08 incorrectly deducted in respect of entitlement to benefits;

(3) the complaint as to the under-payment of the protective award is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£118.80** gross.

2. In relation to the Claims of Miss Stephanie Kirby:

(1) the complaint as to the under-payment of a redundancy payment is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£5.80** gross in respect of an outstanding redundancy payment;

(2) the complaint as to the under-payment of notice pay is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£5.80** gross in respect of an under-payment arising from the calculation of notice pay;

(3) the complaint as to the under-payment of the protective award is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£9.28** gross;



(4) the complaint as to the under-payment of holiday pay is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£374.94** gross.

- 3. In relation to the Claims of Mrs Magda Perduta-Ciecierska, the complaint as to the under-payment of holiday pay is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£461.29** gross.
- 4. In relation to the Claims of Mr Mariusz Sowa:

(1) the complaint as to the under-payment of a redundancy payment is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£140.62** gross in respect of an outstanding redundancy payment;

(2) the complaint as to the under-payment of notice pay is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£140.62** gross in respect of an under-payment arising from the calculation of notice pay;

(3) the complaint as to the under-payment of the protective award is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£562.48** gross.

5. In relation to the Claims of Miss Alina Szazi, the complaint as to the under-payment of notice pay is well founded and the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the further sum of **£73.08** incorrectly deducted in respect of entitlement to benefits.
