# JUDGMENT

The following claims of breach of contract and unlawful deduction of wages are well founded and succeed:

- 1. One week's notice pay
- 2. One day's pay wrongfully deducted from final wages as overpayment of holiday pay
- 3. One day's pay for last day of employment, 23 January 2023

The following claims are not well founded, and fail:

- 4. 2.5 days' pay which were lawfully deducted from final wages as overpayment of holiday pay
- 5. One day's pay for working August bank holiday

6. One week's additional wages

## **REMEDY JUDGMENT**
