## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The Respondent has made unlawful deductions from the Claimant's wages and is ordered to pay to the Claimant the gross sum of £10,431.03, with respect to the wages unlawfully deducted.
- 2. The Respondent has unreasonably failed to comply with Acas Code of Practice on Disciplinary and Grievance Procedures, and it is just and equitable to increase the award by 25% (£2,607.76).
- 3. Therefore, the Respondent must pay to the Claimant the total gross sum of £13,038.79 (£10,431.03 + £2,607.76), less any deductions for tax and National Insurance, for which the Respondent must account to the HMRC.
