The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that:-

- (a) the claimant's claim for unauthorised deductions from pay in respect of deductions in respect of hours worked on 5, 7 and 13 November 2022 is well founded, and the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £42.17 less any appropriate tax;
- (b) the claimants claim for breach of contract in respect of the loss of personal possessions from the company van is unsuccessful and is dismissed.
