# JUDGMENT

## Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

## Case number 1400610/2023 Lewis Mallon

- 1. The claim was issued in the Bristol Employment Tribunals on 02.02.2023. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant **£3330.00** gross.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of **£1215.00**
- 4. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of **£1142.00**
- 5. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £1969.28.
- 6. The respondent must pay the claimant £7656.28 in total.

## Case number 1400618/2023 Vicky Waters.

- 1. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant **£4000.00** gross.
- 2. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £NNNN.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of **£1713.00**
- 4. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £2769.24.
- 5. The respondent must pay the claimant £8,482.24 in total.

## Case number 1400619/2023 Dan Olver.

- 1. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant **£4421.62** gross.
- 2. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of **£???**
- 3. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £1716.00
- 4. The respondent must pay the claimant **£6,137.62** in total.

#### Case number 1401040/2023 Aimee Evans

- 1. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant **£2499.99** gross.
- 2. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £NNNN.???
- 3. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of **£1142.00**
- 4. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £2423.06
- 5. The respondent must pay the claimant £6,065.05 in total.

#### Case number 1401264/2023 Jack Abbott

- 1. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant **£1833.33** gross.
- 2. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of **£423.08**.
- 3. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant **£846.16**
- 4. The respondent must pay the claimant £3,102.57 in total.
