JUDGMENT

This has been a remote hearing for which the parties have raise no objection. The form of remote hearing was by video hearing through HM Courts & Tribunal Cloud Video Platform (wholly remote). A face-to-face hearing was not held because the relevant matters could be determined in this remote hearing.

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is:

- 1. A notice of hearing having been sent to the respondent at the address given on the Response Form and enquiries having been directed towards the respondent, the Tribunal determines that it is fair and appropriate to proceed in the respondent's absence.
- 2. The claimant succeeds in his claims for non-payment of wages, non-payment of pension contributions and failure to pay his accrued but untaken annual leave, totaling £13,389.33 (gross). This is broken down as follows:

Wages: December 2022 to 10 March 2023 @ £42,000pa	£11,140.33
Pension contribution: November 2022 -	£149.00
Annual leave: 13 days -	£2,100.00

Total the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant - £13,389.33
