JUDGMENT

- 1. The complaint that the claimant was unfairly dismissed is struck out.
- 2. The claim for a redundancy payment is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The claimant complains of unfair dismissal and brings a claim for a redundancy payment.
- Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years service to make an unfair dismissal complaint. Under section 155 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 employees do not have a right to a redundancy payment unless they were employed for two years or more except in certain specific circumstances.
- 3. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore the claimant is not entitled to a redundancy payment or to bring a complaint of unfair dismissal.
- 5. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why these complaints should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the complaint of unfair dismissal and the claim for a redundancy payment are struck out. The claimant's other complaints are not affected by this judgment.
