## HM Land Registry Local Land Charges



Appealed planning permissions	The migration tooling between the Local Authority and HM Land Registry is not able to obtain the creation date (i.e. the final appeal decision date) for conditional planning charges that had appeal activity.  An agreement was made that, for migrated charges of this kind, the charge description will contain a brief description of the appeal outcome.  Following migration, creation dates for planning consents with appeal activity will be blank, however there will be no immediate information on the appeal outcome.	Before: Appeal date information would be given on LLC1 search results.  After: Dates relating to appeal information will need to be established via the Sandwell public access planning site. The creation date on HM Land Registry results will be blank for both migrated appealed charges and appealed charges going forward. If no creation date exists on the conditional planning charge there is likely to have been appeal activity.  Example description added to a migrated charge: 'There was appeal activity on this application with the outcome being 'Allowed with Conditions'.
