Thank you for your email of 05 September 2023, requesting the following information:

Please can you tell me how the Defence Clothing Catalogue is broken down? I understand that it is broken into 4 work streams, but i would like to know how many sections each of those streams is in the finished document.

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOI Act). A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD), and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

The current Defence Clothing Catalogue consists of three sections, each of which contains a number of sub-sections. Catalogues are available for each sub-section. The breakdown of sections and sub-sections is as follows:

- Section 1: Combat Clothing
 - o Survival, mountain and arctic warfare equipment
 - Protective Clothing
 - o Combat Clothing
- Section 2: Work Wear and Personal Protective Equipment
 - Crash, Fire and Personal Protection Clothing
 - o Occupation Clothing

 - o Footwear
 - Gloves
 - o Physical Training Equipment
 - Waterproof Garments
 - o Aural, Head, Face, Eye and Respiratory Equipment
 - o Freezer Wear, High Visibility Clothing and Protective Clothing

 - o Materials, Ribbons and Trimmings
