As set out in the Decision, the project considered by the Secretary of State under the EIA Regulations was for the Captain EOR Stage 2 Phase II Field Development, being the project as detailed in Environmental Statement (OPRED reference ES/2022/007) and the application for consent (OGA reference PCON/6546/0).


