Thank you for your email on 26 June 2023, in response to our email of the same date regarding your request for information with the reference RFI 6618. Your request has been dealt with under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR).

In conjunction with your request made under our reference RFI 6618 and applications made under the Farming Equipment and Technology Fund (FETF) 2023 Productivity and Slurry scheme, you have requested the following information:

- A list of all FETF reference numbers, e.g., FETF1, number of applications and successful awards per FETF reference
- The average points score of successful grant awards
- The total number of customers who were not successful and their average points score
- The total value of applications v the total for successful grant awards

You have confirmed that you would like this information broken down by postcode or English county.

Please find the information you have requested in the attached annexes.

- Annex 1 details the number of applications received under each FETF award for each English county.
- Annex 2 details the number of successful applications under each FETF award for each English county.
- Annex 3 details the average points score of successful awards for each English county.
- Annex 4 details the number of unsuccessful applications and their average points score for each English county.
- Annex 5 details the total value of applications and the total value of successful awards for each English county.

What you need to do
