JUDGMENT

- 1. The complaint of unfair dismissal is well-founded and succeeds.
- 2. There is a 75% chance the Claimant would have been fairly dismissed if a fair procedure had been followed. It would have taken a further two weeks to follow a fair procedure.
- The Claimant contributed to her dismissal by culpable and blameworthy conduct.
- 4. Her basic and compensatory awards are reduced by 50% as a result.
- 5. The Respondent did not unreasonably fail to comply with the ACAS Code of Practice.
