JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued in the Leeds Employment Tribunals on 8 July 2023. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant ± 280 gross.
- 3. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant **£280** gross.
- 4. The respondent fail to give the claimant a written statement of employment particulars and the respondent must pay the claimant the sum of **£560** gross.
- 5. The claim for a redundancy payment is dismissed as the claimant did not have the required two years service.
- 6. The respondent must pay the claimant £1190 in total.
