Textual data - Supplementary information length	Some charges exceeded the maximum length for supplementary information. The field was refined to provide full information in fewer characters.	<p>Before: Full text for supplementary information.</p> <p>After: Full description of charge, text refined to provide full charge description within field character limit.</p>
Textual data - Addresses	Addresses have been populated for all charges.	<p>Before: Some charges would only have an address referenced in the description of the charge.</p> <p>After: All charges have addresses or a geographic description of the affected land.</p>
Textual data - Charge types and sub-categories	All charges in the register now contain a charge type and a sub-category in accordance with the HMLR schema.	<p>Before: Subtype = miscellaneous</p> <p>After: charge-type = Housing / buildings charge-sub-category = Works, repairs or authority action (Example of a previous miscellaneous part 4 charge)</p>
Textual data - Originating authority	The originating authority for ancient monuments is now set to "Historic England"	<p>Before: Blaby District Council</p> <p>After: Historic England</p>
Further information location for ancient monuments and listed building	Add a link to Historic England's website for ancient monuments and listed building charges	<p>Before: Blaby District Council details</p> <p>After: https://historicengland.org.uk/listing/the-list/</p>
Textual data – Local authority references	All conditional planning charges will contain two references, a planning reference and a TLC reference.	<p>Now: Planning Ref: 88/0534/1/PB TLC Ref: PT51072</p>
