JUDGMENT

1. The Respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made on the claim or part of it in accordance with Rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
2. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £1069.42 (calculated at 3 weeks x £356.42).
3. The claimant was made redundant and the Respondent must pay a redundancy payment to the claimant of £1069.42 (calculated at 3 years x 1 x £356.42).
4. The respondent failed to pay the claimant loss of earnings (including sums for pension) and must pay to the claimant the sum of £82.30;
5. The total award of £2,221.14 is payable forthwith.
