Morning

Our research shows that significantly more material has been deposited on the site than required to form the tees and greens for the golf course extension as approved. However there are a couple of greens and tees where the levels on the approved drawings have not reached those shown on the approved drawings but this is not significant. In the Council's opinion given the amount of unauthorised material deposited on the site there is no need to import further material to complete the development.

The Council will shortly be serving an enforcement notice(s) requiring the land to be restored to the levels as of July 2017. The Council will not be requiring the material deposited on the land prior to 2017 to be removed because of the impact on the road network and the surroundings.
