JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's employer was Sainsbury's Supermarkets Ltd; the Respondent's details are therefore substituted from Sainsbury's Plc to Sainsbury's Supermarkets Ltd.
- 2. The Claimant's claims for constructive unfair dismissal and 'other type of claim' are struck out.

Reasons

- 3. Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a Claimant to have not less than two years' service to make a complaint of unfair dismissal. The Claimant was employed by the Respondent for less than two years. The Claimant is therefore not entitled to bring such a complaint.
- 4. The Claimant's claims for 'other types of claim' are struck out as disclosing no reasonable prospects of success.
