### **JUDGMENT OF THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNAL**

For the reasons given orally at the Hearing on the 18<sup>th</sup> January 2023 the Employment Tribunal finds as follows.

1. That the correct designation of the respondent should be Craig Jackson trading as Mains of Scotstown Inn and that the claim is amended accordingly.
2. That the claim for unlawful deductions is well founded.

3. That the respondent shall pay to the claimant the sum of £673.38 (57 hours x £13.45 less £100 paid to account) being an unlawful deduction of accrued wages due to the claimant by the respondent less £100 which the claimant acknowledges was paid to account.
