JUDGMENT

- 1. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is made out and succeeds.
- 2. The Respondent must pay the Claimant the sum of £1,099.82, calculated as follows:

2.3. Car allowance (£103.65 x 6)	621.90
2.4. Expenses	344.00

2.5.1. Sums paid by the Respondent to the Claimant	(4692.00)

- 3. The Respondent must account to HMRC for the tax and national insurance due on the salary and holiday pay payments made to the Claimant.
- 4. The Employment Protection (Recoupment of Jobseeker's Allowance & Income Support) Regulations 1996 do not apply.
