- 2. Holiday pay: the Respondent failed to pay to the Claimant holiday pay due for 7 days accrued but untaken holiday, as at 17 February 2023, amounting to £595.00 gross.
- 3. In consequence of the above the Respondent SHALL pay to the Claimant unpaid wages and holiday pay of £3,871.39, subject to tax and National Insurance (the usual statutory deductions).
