Dynamic Risk Assessment (DRA) complements the generic, specific and / or specialised higher-hazard risk assessment. Regardless of completing this form, or amending a hazard log, it is beholden on the person managing the risk to continue to monitor the activity and the control measures. Changes immediately before it starts or during the activity (incl. environmental conditions) or control measures, **must** be addressed using a dynamic risk assessment so risks remain ALARP and tolerable. (If applicable).
