Veterinary confirmation of neutering

Confirm an XL Bully dog has been neutered.

When to use this form

Owners of XL Bully dogs who want to keep their dog must provide evidence of neutering to Defra.

Defra will use the form as evidence that the owner has met the neutering requirement for the dog's Certificate of Exemption to remain valid.

XL Bully dogs must be permanently neutered. Male dogs must be neutered through castration, and female dogs must be spayed. The procedure must be carried out by a Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons (RCVS)-registered veterinary surgeon, or they must confirm that it has been previously neutered.

Deadlines for providing evidence that your dog has been neutered

You must provide Defra with evidence that your XL Bully dog has been neutered on or before the relevant deadline.

Age of the dog on 31 January 2024	Deadline for receipt of_form
12 months old or older	26 July 2024 (but the dog must have been neutered by 30 June 2024)
At least 7 months old, but less than 12 months old	31 December 2024
Less than 7 months old	30 June 2025

Defra will contact the dog owner if there any issues verifying the information on this form.


