## JUDGMENT ON RECONSIDERATION

- 1. The Tribunal reconsidered its Judgment on its own volition.
- 2. The Respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made on the claim or part of it in accordance with Rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £1069.42 (calculated at 3 weeks x £356.42).
- 4. The claimant was made redundant and the Respondent must pay a redundancy payment to the claimant of £1069.42 (calculated at 3 years x 1 x £356.42).
- 5. The total award of £2,138.84 is payable forthwith.
